HIGHWAY SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT

Whereas, the Village of Attica Foreman of Highways reported that the Village of Attica currently shares equipment, materials and services with other Wyoming County municipalities and neighboring counties on an informal basis

and to be in compliance with the New York State Highway Law and General Municipal Law, the Village of Attica is required to adopt an agreement formalizing this arrangement; and

Whereas, the Foreman of Highways reported that municipalities, including the Village of Attica, have the power and authority to contract for the purpose of renting, leasing, exchanging, borrowing, or maintaining of machinery and equipment, with our without operators, with the municipalities: and

Whereas, the Foreman of Highways reported that it has been determined that the Village of Attica and other municipalities have machinery and equipment which are not used during certain periods and have stored materials and supplies which are not immediately needed; and

Whereas, it has been determined that by renting, borrowing, exchanging, leasing or maintaining highway machinery and equipment and the borrowing or lending of materials and supplies, the Village of Attica and other municipalities may avoid the necessity of purchasing certain needed highway machinery and equipment and the purchasing of or storing a large inventory of certain extra materials and supplies, thereby saving the taxpayers money; and

Whereas, it is the intent of the Village of Attica to give the Village's Foreman of Highways the authority to enter into renting, exchanging, borrowing, lending or maintaining arrangements with the persons serving in similar capacities in other municipalities without the necessity of obtaining approval of the Village governing board prior to the making of each individual arrangement; and

Whereas, the Foreman of Highways has presented an agreement which is expected to be adopted and placed into effect in other municipalities and will grant the person holding the position comparable to that of the head of the highway department authority to make such arrangements and has requested approval of this agreement by the Attica Village Board; and

Whereas, the Attica Village Board has determined that it is in the best interest of the Village to be a party to such shared services arrangement.

Now, Therefore, be it resolved, that the Village Mayor or administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Highway Shared Services Agreement, which shall be effective immediately for five (5) years and shall expire five (5) years from the date of its signing. The Village Board shall review this agreement each year, and be it **Further Resolved**, that the Village Clerk is authorized and directed to file a copy of the Highway Shared Services agreement with the Village Clerk and Superintendent of highways of each municipality within the County of Wyoming.
