## 2023-96 SEQR resolution for Water Treatment Plant Improvements project

**Recommended Action**: that the Village Board approves the following resolution:

# VILLAGE OF ATTICA SEQR RESOLUTION - NEGATIVE DECLARATION VILLAGE OF ATTICA WATER TREATMENT PLANT IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

#### WHEREAS,

- 1. In accordance with the New York State Environmental Quality Review regulations (SEQR), the Board of Trustees of the Village of Attica announced its intent to serve as Lead Agency on August 16, 2023, to conduct an environmental review of the Village of Attica Water Treatment Plant Improvements Project. The project involves the construction of an approximately 1,500 square foot addition to the existing building at the Village's Water Treatment Plant (WTP) located at 3368 Dunbar Road in the Village of Attica (SBL 19.-1-54). Additionally, the Village proposes to construct an approximate 500 SF pumphouse on a portion of (No #) Dunbar Road (SBL 19.-1-58). The building expansion and pumphouse will facilitate the installation of new treatment systems. Proposed site improvements, including those necessary for the building expansion, include: driveway modification, fill and grading, relocation of overhead electrical lines, buried piping modifications, septic system replacement, and exterior pump enclosure removal. Overall, the amount of ground disturbance will be limited to approximately 2 acres on the existing WTP site.
- 2. The Village Board has determined that the proposed action is an "Type I Action" as defined under SEQR.
- 3. The Village Board, in its capacity of Lead Agency, has caused to be prepared an environmental assessment of the significance of and potential environmental impact of the action described above.
- 4. On August 16, 2023, the Village Board notified the Involved and Interested Agencies of its intention to act as Lead Agency for this project and circulated Part 1 of the long Environmental Assessment Form.

- 5. Comments received on the project have been addressed in Part 2 of the Environmental Assessment Form. The Village will continue to work with Federal, State and local agencies until all necessary permits and approvals have been obtained.
- 6. The Village Board has considered the Environmental Record prepared for this action, including any comments received from the Involved Agencies, and the proposed Negative Declaration.

#### NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,

The Village Board declares that it will serve as Lead Agency for the Village of Attica Water Treatment Plant Improvements Project; and,

The Village Board declares that, based on the Environmental Record which has been prepared, the project will result in no major impacts and, therefore, will not cause significant damage to the environment. A Negative Declaration under SEQR is therefore issued for this project.
