### RESOLUTION TO SCHEDULE A PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE ROUND 8 RESTORE NY COMMUNITIES **INITIATIVE MUNICIPAL GRANT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Empire State Development Corporation is requesting funding proposals for the sixth round of the Restore NY Municipal Grant program; and

WHEREAS, grant funds are available for projects to demolish/deconstruct and/or rehabilitate/reconstruct vacant, abandoned, surplus and/or condemned residential, commercial and/or mixed-use buildings; and

WHEREAS, an important goal of Restore NY is to revitalize urban centers, rural areas, and disadvantaged communities. It is anticipated that upon completion, the projects funded by Restore NY grants will attract individuals, families, and industry and commercial enterprises to the municipality. It is further anticipated that the improved community and business climate will result in an increased tax base thereby improving municipal finances and the wherewithal to further grow the municipality's tax and resource base, lessening its dependence on state aid; and

WHEREAS, cities with populations less than 40,000 can apply for up to \$2,000,000 in grant funding;

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the application and properties involved in the application is required prior to submission,

**NOW THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED** by the Village of Attica Board that it hereby schedules a public hearing for the Round 8 Restore NY application for May 21, 2024 at 6 p.m. at Village Hall, 9 Water Street, Attica, NY, 14011.

## 2024-36 SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM INFLOW & INFILTRATION REMEDIATION PROJECT, SEQR RESOLUTION – INTENT TO DECLARE LEAD AGENCY STATUS

WHEREAS, the Village of Attica Sanitary Sewer System Inflow and Infiltration Remediation Project (hereinafter the "Project") involves sealing manholes and pipelines through lining and spot repairs and sealing stormwater connections from the sewage collection system through replacement of broken cleanout covers, and rerouting of connections (such as downspouts and foundation drains) from the sanitary sewer to storm drainage infrastructure such as catch basins and bioswales; and

WHEREAS, environmental review of the Project is required pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA); and

WHEREAS, that the Project is classified as a Type I Action as defined under SEQRA; and WHEREAS, the Village of Attica has retained LaBella Associates, D.P.C. to prepare Part 1 of the SEQRA Full Environmental Assessment Form for the project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that in accordance with SEQRA, the Village of Attica intends to serve as Lead Agency to conduct a coordinated environmental review of the Project pursuant to SEQRA.

FURTHER RESOLVED, the Village of Attica will notify any Involved and Interested Agencies of its intention to act as Lead Agency for this Project and will provide them with a copy of the completed Part 1 of the Full Environmental Assessment Form for review.
