4-1. Assemblages restricted.

It shall be unlawful for persons to assemble and remain around or near the entrance of any church, hall, railroad depot or any public place, store, shop or dwelling, or at or near any corner or in any other part of any street, unless, engaged in some lawful business or avocation requiring them so to remain, or while necessarily waiting to pass to or from or along any such place, street, store, shop or dwelling.

4-2. Violations and penalties.

Whoever shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall for each offense forfeit and pay a sum not exceeding five dollars (\$5.) for the use of the Village of Attica.

4-3. Effective date.

This act shall take effect on the first day of July, 1898.
