

Access to our park and greenspaces matter more than ever for our mental and physical health. The Village of Attica will slowly open our park starting June 15, 2020. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic we will open with the following restrictions:

1. Playground is now open.
2. The Park road is open for drive through and parking is available.
3. The main bathroom will be open, all others will remain closed.
4. Basketball courts will be restricted to single use per basket. (due to contact restrictions)
5. No gatherings anywhere in the park of more than 50 including any pavilion (must practice social distancing, or wear masks if you cannot maintain 6 ft)
6. The youth recreation program is cancelled
7. The wading pool will not be open.

The Village will be:

1. Cleaning and sanitizing the main bathroom twice a day
2. Monitoring activity in the park for the safety of our residents and staff
3. Posting proper signage through-out the park

What should people visiting the park do?....

1. Staying home if you are sick or do not feel well
2. Using social distancing and maintaining at least six feet between individuals in all areas of the park.
3. Covering coughs and sneezes with a tissue, then throwing the tissue in the trash.
4. Washing hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom, before eating, and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
5. Using hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol if soap and water are not available.
6. Avoiding touching eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
7. Be considerate and wear a mask to protect others, as recommended by state and federal authorities.
8. Leave no trace- Please carry out everything you take in with you, including dog waste.
